Corrections

- PDF volume counter and warning: If a job is bigger than the remaining allowed PDF volume allows, then the entire job is discarded by DocOut, the host is notified, an error entry is made to Windows Application Event log, and the PDF volume counter is reset to the value it had prior to the job. Prior to this correction, a job exceeding the limit would cause the PDF volume counter to be set to max value +1 and prevent further printing.

IPDS:

- Fixed error where tiny embedded JPEG objects causes memory violation.
- Improved support for IOCA FS11 JPEG objects.
- Correct handling where host attempts to use a font that has not been previously declared.
- Space characters as Dynamic spacing is now supported.
- Use of same Font LID in text and overlays is now supported.
- Correction for paper size definition for matrix printing letter/legal.
- Improved RGB ⇔ CMYK conversion rule.
- Improved handling of FS45 images in JPEG objects.

ICDS:

- When creating PDF optimized for fast web view, reusing overlay caused used fonts to not get referenced correctly.
- Print direction after overlay inclusion for PCL output corrected.
- Color correction for PS output when overlay wrongly printed with wrong color. Correction ensures that color is selected before printing overlay.
- Fix for malformed replace string causing DocOut to hang.

DCA:

- Output to Postscript file created 2 files.
- Horizontal PCL positioning correction.
- Correction for malformed FSL structure in DCA data stream.

SCS:

TN3270: Support for LU3 commands corrected.

Important notice:

Adobe has discontinued DDE support for Acrobat Reader, therefore Print with Acrobat Reader from DocOut only works for Acrobat Reader versions 9 or older.
